- Acting 250: An introduction to basic acting theory (Stanislavsky-based) through a number of improvisations and physical exercises related to exploring actions and objectives. Students also individually coached on monologues.
- <u>Acting 251</u>: Students continue deeper work on text analysis, action theory, and subtext as they are coached through a new monologue and two rounds of assigned scene work in pairs.
- <u>Acting 252</u>: Students work in groups to develop their own 10-minute performance piece, drawn from an assigned contemporary text. The focus is on ensemble work, self-production, rehearsal strategies, and artistic ownership as well as text analysis, character development.
